

For those who would like to attend the Live, In-person Sunday Worship Service:

- Using conservative interpretations of County and Diocesan guidance, **we will limit capacity to 50 parishioners** in the nave of the Church;
- Please do not plan to attend these services if you have underlying health conditions or are of a venerable age that may render you more vulnerable to infection should anyone around you unknowingly be infected with COVID-19 or other communicable illnesses – your safety and wellness are very important to us;
- As long as parish leadership feels we can conscientiously follow scientifically-based, civic, and ecclesiastical guidelines for public safety, no one will be turned away – these maximum attendance guidelines are for everyone’s safety, are not absolute, and not at all meant to be unfairly discriminatory;
- Please do not attend a service if you have a fever, cough, feel unwell, or are experiencing symptoms of illness – everyone else’s safety and wellness are very important to us, too;
- Again, according to County and Diocesan guidance, **we will ask that you wear a face mask or covering while in the church** – we may have a few disposable ones here available to you, but cannot guarantee that week by week;
- We will ask that **you enter by the one marked “Entrance” door, and after worship exit through the one marked “Exit” door** to help us with the safest flow of foot traffic in and out of the church;
- We will ask that you **make liberal use of the provided hand sanitizer gel upon entering the church;**
- We will ask that you **worship six feet or even further apart from your fellow worshipers**, including skipping pews if necessary in front and behind others (families and households may sit together);
- Pew cushions, Hymnals and Prayer Books have been removed for now, but we will have full service bulletins available;
- We will ask that you strictly limit your visit to the church and courtyard – one set of restrooms will be available, and while **we will provide nursery for child care**, there will be no access to the chapel and Lillycrop Room, nor the kitchen, parish hall, or other areas – this is a matter of cleaning and disinfecting for everyone’s safety, and we are working hard to provide the safest spaces week by week;
- Your patience, compliance, forbearance, and charity will help make this run as smoothly as possible, and in advance we thank you!
